Annual Statement on Research Integrity February 2020

This is AECC University College's statement on research integrity in compliance with the Concordat to Support Research Integrity.

We recognise the importance of conducting all research activity at the University College aligned with the highest standards of rigor and integrity and are a signatory to the Concordat as of December 2017

We propose the following changes:

- Change to the name and Terms of Reference of the Research and Staff Development Committee
 - The Research and Staff Development Committee is now renamed the Research and Innovation Committee (Academic Board 22nd January 2020)
 - The new Research and Innovation Committee Terms of Reference retains the same oversight of the assurance of the integrity of research as the old committee

This statement covers the 12-month period to 1st February 2020 in relation to research misconduct covering both staff and students and confirms that there were no allegations of research misconduct received.

The Director of Research is responsible for overseeing research integrity at AECC University College and is the first point of contact for anyone wanting more information on matters of research integrity.
