



VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

for all NHS Courses

(Radiography, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech & Language Therapy, Podiatry and Dietetics)

It is strongly advised that applicants get/start the vaccination requirements as soon as possible once they intend to undertake an NHS course. If you do not have paper evidence of the vaccinations required to provide to our occupational health provider, **then you will need to contact your GP and obtain this information**. This may incur a change.

If you need vaccinations you should contact your GP as soon as possible in the first instance. They may undertake them free of charge or there might be an associated cost.

Please note: you may be able to get vaccinations completed more affordably via the GP or local pharmacies, travel clinics or private clinics than the costs which will be applied via our Occupational Health provider.

COVID-19

We **strongly advise** that all students are up to date with their COVID-19 vaccinations. This vaccination **may not be mandatory but** it might, if you have not had it, impact the type of practice learning opportunities you can access or experience. This is to ensure the protection of vulnerable patients.

Hepatitis B

Three doses are required. The second injection is given four weeks after the first and the third injection needs to follow five months later. It is critical that you commence this process prior to your arrival in order not to delay placements. Hep B vaccines are also given at sexual health clinics.

*These blood tests are only required if evidence is not provided with your OH preclearance form.

+ These two vaccines (MMR and Chickenpox) are given if the blood test shows no immunity, that is why it is important to obtain evidence from your GP for childhood immunisations.

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! Tuberculosis (BCG) vaccinations, if there is no evidence of the vaccine provided or no visible BCG scar then the normal appointment charges are Mantoux Test £49 and BCG vaccination (48 hours post Mantoux test) £51 = £100

Standard HepB course = Hep B x 3 vaccines, 1 x Hep B Blood Test and 1 x Hep B 12 month booster = £265.50
